What we want the students to know:

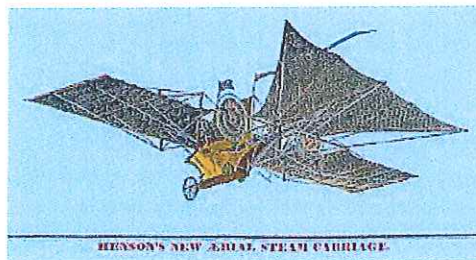
1. Investigate flight by observation of flight in different situations
